“You are the Salt of the earth and the Light of the world.”

Today's Gospel account continues the Sermon on the Mount, begun last Sunday. Jesus specifically addresses his disciples, with the repeated use of “you” and “your”. Like prophets before him, Jesus demands not just words, but actions which call us as his followers to act according to his view of righteousness. To hear his teaching and fail to act upon it is worthless, like salt that has lost its flavour. On the other hand, people who live according to his teaching give glory to God, thus being the light of the world. Today we are reminded of our noble calling of bringing Jesus into the world. **The brightness of our lives as we follow in the footsteps of Christ enlightens the path of God for those around us. Christ has placed his Gospel into our hands and it depends on us whether or not it is proclaimed.** In order that his message be seen for what it is, may we put it into practice in our lives through our good works that are the salt which gives flavour and sparkles the light of Christ to shine forth for all to see!
